Building and Other Construction Workers
(RE&CS) Act 1996 and Cess Act 1996 in
Jammu and Kashmir State upto 29.02.2016.**

Subject: - Status report with regard to collection of cess/disbursement on account of welfare schemes under Building and Other Construction workers act in Jammu and Kashmir State.

- (1) **LEGISLATIONS:** The Central Government has enacted the legislations, namely “the Building and Other Construction Workers” (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996” and “the Building and Other Construction Workers” Welfare Cess Act, 1996” with the object to regulate the employment and conditions of service and to provide safety, health and welfare measures for the Building and Other Construction Workers, which is most vulnerable segment of the second largest unorganized labour sector in India after Agriculture.
- (2) **Framing of Rules:** - Government of Jammu and Kashmir has issued SRO-232 of 2006 and SRO-373 of 2012 amended in June 2013 with regard to implementation of Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act 1996.
- (3) **Appointment of Various Officers under the Act:** The Labour and Employment Department has notified the Enforcement Officers of the Directorate to act in various capacity as Inspectors, Registering Officers, Assessing Officers, Cess Collectors, Appellate Officers etc.
- (4) **Constitution of the Board:** The State Government initially Vide SRO-274 of 31-7-2007 constituted J&K Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board for a period of three years as mandated in the Act and re-constituted subsequently on the expiry of due term, latest vide SRO No. 355 dated 0th October 2015.
- (5) **Creation of Staff:-**
 - I. Vide Government Order No. 117-L&E of 2010 dated: 20-10-2010 post as per the detail given below were created:

(a) Chief Executive Officer/Secretary (b) Accounts Officer (c) Section Officer (d) Accountant (e) Accounts Assistant (f) Senior Assistant (g) Junior Assistant (h) Driver (i) Orderly.

II. Vide Government order NO. 100-L&E of 2011 dated 20.12.2011 twenty two posts of Junior Assistants have been created for J&K Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board.

III. Process for creation of additional staff for the Office of CEO/Secretary and all the Districts is under active consideration of the Board.

(6) **Establishment of office:** - J&K BOCWWB has full-fledged office both at Jammu as well as Srinagar in a rented accommodation and moves biannually with Civil Secretariat.

(7) **Collection of Cess:** - Detail of cess collected, monthly contribution, registration fee and interest accrued upto 31-01-2016 is **Rs. 477.85 crore** (Rupees four hundred seventy seven crore and eighty five lacs Only)

(8) Meeting of the Board/detail of Welfare Schemes: Upto 29-02-2016 Twelve (12) meetings of the Board have been held in which various decisions including the approval of welfare schemes for J&K Building and Other Construction Workers were taken like Education Assistance, Assistance for Accident and disability, Assistance in case of Death, Maternity benefit, Funeral Expenses, Marriage Assistance etc. Scheme for providing the Housing loan and covering the registered construction worker under various Insurance schemes besides launching of Pension Scheme and medical care facilities at the work places are under consideration of the Board.

(9) District wise detail of registration of Construction Worker / Disbursement on account of Welfare Schemes / Beneficiaries covered

Upto 31.01.2016 2.88 Lac Construction Workers have been registered. An amount of Rs164.32 Crore have been released to the Assistant Labour Commissioners (Authorized Officers) for payment to the Registered Construction Workers on welfare schemes, out of which Rs. 154 Crore has been disbursed to the Beneficiaries. Note: - compilation of Scheme wise payment is under process however more than eighty percent (80%) Expenditure have been made on account of different Welfare Schemes.

(11) **Awareness**:- Due momentum is given to the publicity and awareness of various welfare schemes implemented by the Board through various modes of communication and education. The Board has advertised various schemes through PBBCI, Local TV Channels, FM Radio and Doordarshan. Recently a full page Ad, depicting therein the functions and schemes of the Board was given in various leading newspapers in Hindi, Urdu and English.

(12) **Supply of Stationery**: The Board has got printed various Forms, Registers and Identity Cards from Government Press Jammu and has distributed the same to all the Assistant Labour Commissioner of the State.

(13) **Registration of Employers/Establishment**: - As per the report taken from registering officers viz Assistant Labour Commissioner's **534** (Five Hundred and Thirty Four) establishments/employers have been registered. J&K Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board has issued a circular mentioning therein the clarification regarding the implementation of Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act 1996 and Cess Act to all the executing agencies in the state like R&B, PMGSY, JKPC, PDD, PHE, JMC, SMC, Garrison Engineer etc. It has also enjoined upon all the executing agencies to provide the facilities to the Building and Construction Workers at the work place and take all the precautionary measures for the safety and health of them.

(14) **Launching of Website**:- J&K Building and Other Construction Workers Welfare Board has launched the Website with the Domain Name www.jkbocwb.org. therein given all the details about the registration and the format downloading etc. The updation/construction of various dynamic pages is under process. We are taking every possible step to make the website more easy beneficial and attractive for the construction workers thereby uploading all the information pertaining to the implementation of the schemes as well as cess provisions.

(15) **Audit of the funds**: As per the directions passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court on 07-02-2012 for conducting the audit of the funds of the Board, Pr.

Accountant General (Audit J&K), Jammu has conducted Audit of the Board upto 31.03.2013 report of which has been received.

The Board is trying its level best to register maximum construction workers in the current financial year, so that the benefits of various schemes could reach to them.
