Subject: Grant of relaxation to registered Building and Other Construction Workers for deposit of monthly contribution fee as arrears from the date of registration/default.

Whereas this office has granted relaxation to BOC, workers for deposition of monthly contribution from the date of registration or default as arrears through Circular No's CEO/J&K/BCB/018/7385-7411 dated 07.12.2018 and 32-JKBOCWWB of 2019 dated 18.01.2019.

Whereas most of the BOC Workers turned for renewal of registration during the relaxation period granted, as per the reports of the Registering Authorities.

Whereas still representations have been received from various Deputy Commissioners, Labour Unions, workers and Registering Officers (Assistant Labour Commissioners) that some Building and Other Construction Workers registered as beneficiary under the Act could not deposit the mandatory monthly contribution during the said period, resultantly they are not eligible for the benefits extended by the Board on account of various welfare/social security schemes, citing the reasons of harsh winter and non-connectivity, blockade of National Highway, migration of labourers during winter season to outside State, etc.

The matter was examined thoroughly and the grounds given for non-renewal of Monthly Contribution Fee during the relaxation time seems to be justified to a larger extent.

Now therefore, in terms of the powers vested under Section (17) of the Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act 1996 and in the larger interest of Construction Workers, the delay is hereby condoned and the relaxation is granted to left-out construction workers to deposit Monthly Contribution Fee (MCF) as arrears in a single instalment upto 20th July 2019 in the offices of Registering officers (Assistant Labour Commissioners), subject to the terms and conditions as laid down in the Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act 1996 and Rules made thereunder. Any construction worker registered under the Act, who fails to deposit the arrears upto the cut-off date shall cease to be a construction worker/beneficiary.
